INTRODUCTION

The objective of "Devbhoomi Development Society, Chandi is to establish and run educational, technical and professional institutions for the promotion of education, particular in the villages of the State. To fulfill its aims and objectives, the society has established VSLM College of Education Chandi, in the cherished memory of late Vaidh Shankar Lal a Social Activist and Educationist. The Society is running two Department i.e. Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) and Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.).

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

VSLM College of Education is an Educational Institution with a difference where the students are encouraged, rewarded and appreciated for their active involvement in maintaining discipline and organizing other activities required. The College was established by committee duly constituted as per the norms of Himachal Pradesh University. It is Co-educational College of Education. The College has been granted NOC by the State government of Himachal Pradesh and recognition by National Council for Teacher Education. The College is affiliated with Himachal Pradesh University Shimla. For B.Ed. vide their letter No. 1-304/2006 -HPU 2008. The College is also affiliated with Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education Dharamshala for D.El.Ed. vide letter No. HB/affiliation/43/2008-20566-565 dated 19 September 2008

The college is recognised from NCTE for B.Ed. Vide Order/Letter No. F.NRC/NCTE/7/5051 dated August 23, 2006 & F.No./NRC/HP-179/2015/1113/ dated 05 June, 2015. The College is permitted for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students (Medical, Non-Medical & Arts). 50 students for D.El.Ed. course. The college has five storey building with all necessary infrastructure and instructional facilities as per the norms of Government of Himachal Pradesh / NCTE / H.P. University and H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala to run the curricular activities and beautiful campus having its own play grounds. The College subscribes to several important academic journals, magazines and newspaper. The Department of Physical Education is well-equipped with most of the indoor and outdoor sports/games for both men and women. The College has a Hostel accommodation within the college campus separately for Boys and Girls with all necessary facilities.

LOCATION

VSLM College of Education is located in the outskirts of Shimla Hill at a distance of 58 km. from Shimla via Kunihar. 20 km. from Kasauli Hill Station and 18 km. from Subathu Contonment Area, 45 km. from Nalagarh, having regular Bus Service.



FACULTY

The management has engaged competent and well qualified teaching staff as per the norms of the National Council for Teaching Education (NCTE)/Himachal Pradesh University and Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education Dharamshala.

ADMISSION

The basis of B.Ed. course is the common entrance test (C.E.T.) conducted by the University, for B.Ed. the basis of admission is merit and subsequent counseling conducted by the Himachal Pradesh University Shimla. The process of admission to the D.El.Ed. course is the common entrance test (C.E.T.) conducted by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala. For the admission to the B.Ed. 85% seats are reserved for the students who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. University for any other recognized University established by Law in India, 10% seats are reserved for management. No direct admission is possible. The process of admission of the college is given below.

1. Fill up the admission form attached with the prospectus.
2. Paste your photo at specified place on the forms.
3. Enclose following documents with the admission form.
 - (i) Attested copies of **DETAILED MARKS SHEETS AND CERTIFICATE** matriculation onwards.
 - (ii) Caste certificate in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
 - (iii) Character certificate from the institution last attended.
 - (iv) Five passport size Photographs.
 - (v) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
 - (vi) Aadhaar Card
 - (vii) H.P.U. Registration card. (only for B. Ed . Course)
 - (viii) Bonafide Certificate.
1. Bring all original documents and attested Photostat copies of all the documents at the time of admission in the college.
2. For fee details, consult the clerk/Accountant.
3. Deposit the fee either in cash or through Bank Draft.

FEE AND OTHER CHARGES

- Fee for B.Ed. course will be charged as per the notification of State Govt./H.P. University Shimla time to time.
- Fee for D.El.Ed. course will be charged as per the notification of State Govt./H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala. The seats are bifurcated as subsidized seats and Non-subsidized seats in the ratio of 50%
- H.P. University/Board charges relating to examination, examination fee, Migration fee, youth welfare fee, Holiday Home fee and other charges taken by the university/Board as application from time will be charged in addition to the general fees.

Note:

- The fees once paid will not be refundable/adjustable/transferable.
- The fee will be subject to change as per H.P. Government notifications.
- If student does not attend the college within week of the opening day as announced, his/her admission stand cancelled.
- All dues must be cleared before examination.

IMPORTANT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The wearing of the uniform prescribed by the institution will be compulsory during college hours and college function for all the students.
2. The trainee will assembled daily for a morning prayer.
3. Any trainee who create nuisance in college will be fined heavily by the Principal/HOD.
4. Mobile phones strictly banned in the campus and classrooms. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against who found using mobile phone in the college campus during college time.
5. All trainee are advised to see the notice board daily. No excuse will be entertained if a trainee fails to read important notice, the consequence of this will upon the trainee. No one is allowed to remove the notice put by the college. The identified will be fined/liabel to disciplinary action.
6. During the period of training must not involve/attend in any anti govt...anti-college or subversive activities, Extreme penalty for such activity is expulsion from the college and for failure of character certificate.
7. No public recognition will be given to the trainees violating college discipline or not showing good behavior.

8. The student should be regular in attendance and punctual at all official functions of the college.
9. The trainees shall co-operative with the college authorities in maintaining cleanliness, order and discipline on the campus, as well as high standards of excellence.
10. Every trainee is required to carry his/her Identity Card daily while in the campus, it may be checked at any time by the Principal and Staff authority.

Leave Rules

- * prior Leave must be sanctioned by the on a prescribed Performa, obtained from the college.
- * Attendance in teaching practice (Micro, Real, Criticism Lessons), house test, extension lectures.
- * Absentees without permission will be fined. (Rs 50/- per absent)
- * If a student remains absent for more than 7 consecutive days without leave, the Principal/ H.O.D. reserve the right to struck off the name of the student from the rolls of the institute.

EXAMINATION

To appear in house tests is compulsory for every student, fine of Rs. 150/- per subject will be charged for absence.

Any student is eligible to appear in the annual University/Board Examination if he/she:

1. a) For B.Ed. Course, Attended minimum of 90% of lectures delivered (the course to be counted up the break for preparatory holidays).
b) Attended minimum of 75% of the period assigned to practical work in each subject.
2. a) For D.El.Ed. Course, Attended minimum of 90% of lectures delivered (the course to be counted up the break for preparatory holidays).
b) Attended minimum of 90% of the period assigned to practical work in each subject.

3. Obtained minimum pass marks in each subject in the house examination/assignments. Absence from lecture, tutorials seminars, practical etc. on account of participation in university, inter-university, State National-International Meets or Tournaments, Youth Festivals and Cultural competitions, including the actual time spent in journey, shall be exempted and shall be considered as attendance for the purpose above mentioned.

THE LIBRARY

The college has a well-equipped Library with a large number of standard books (exceeding 8517), including text books, reference books, standard dictionaries, encyclopedias, educational survey and books of general interest. The college subscribes to several important academic journal (more than 20) magazines and newspaper. It has a spacious reading room to accommodate 100 students. The Library has been carefully planned to have more space and natural lighting for the comfort of the users. The Library is fully ventilated. The Libraries committed to provided a world-class information support to its users.



LIBRARY RULES:

The students are required to follow the rules and regulations given below:

1. A student may draw any number of books for reading in the library during specified hours.
2. Each student is allowed to borrow 2 books at a time from the library.
3. Books borrow may be retained for 14 days including the day of issue.
4. The books borrowed must be returned on the due date otherwise a fine of Rs. 10/- will be charged for first three days beyond which double of the standing amount will be chargeable per day.
5. If a student fails to pay fine which is due to be paid, he/she sill not be allowed further issue of books unless and unit the fine is remitted.
6. A book, can however, be re-issued with the special permission of the librarian if it is not in demand.
7. Periodicals, directories, dictionaries and special reference books shall not be issued to any member for reading at home these will be available for the study in the library only.
8. The books issued to any student should not be sub-letted to any other person. The teacher shall be liable to face disciplinary action or special fine.
9. In case any library book is lost the borrower shall be required to replace the latest edition of the lost book or to pay double its price.
10. No outsider should be accompanied into the library.
11. Any book issued to member may be recalled in case it is urgently needed for any other reason.

12. Students are advised to keep perfect silence in the library.
13. The library hours are from 11.00 am to 04.00 pm.
14. If any student damages the book in any manner he/she will be liable to pay a fine of Rs. 100/-.
15. Leave from college does not imply exemption from the return of books. The books may be returned to library through the messenger or by registered post.

NOTE:

Every student will have to deposit library security (Refundable) Rs. 1000/- The Principal has full authority to change the rules and regulations from time to time.

REFUND OF SECURITY

The securities will be refunded after the student has left the college within six months only. Securities that remain unclaimed thereof. No refund will be entertained after that period. and the unclaimed amount will be utilized for the welfare

FACILITIES

- **I.T. cum E.T. Lab.:** The institute has well equipped I.T. cum E.T. lab comprising Twenty Five computers connected with 24 hours broadband internet connection and networking is complete having installed all modern electric and electronic devices viz. over Head Projector (O.H.P.), display screen T.V., Tape Recorder, DVD Player, VCDs/CDs on different subjects, Microphones, Amplifier and a number of illustrative model and charts of different subject. Students are given two hours minimum on the computer. All students have equal opportunity to access internet free of charges at any time for research and education purpose. The Students are provided with first hand experience on the devices frequently.
- The psychology Lab of the institute consists of a large number of psychological tests and other equipments necessary to measure different psychological variables. The students are given a thorough practice of the tests and their practical utility.
- The institute has a proper Science and Mathematics, S. St. and curriculum lab Equipped with all required equipments and teaching aid materials.
- Health and Physical Education Resources Centre are housed in well designed spacious rooms with adequate electricity and water connections, tools, equipments, health models, body charts, posters, booklets and Laptops.
- Fine Arts and Music resources centre of college is well equipped with all instruments and material. Resource centre are house in a well designed spacious room with adequate electricity and tools, equipments, furniture, raw material, reference materials/books, periodicals and motivational works.



- College is having a multi purpose hall of covered area 4200 sq. ft. with ultra modern facilities like LCD Projectors, Over Head Projectors, Public Address System extra, All the seminars, Prayer, Functions Parties and social activities for better arrangement of society organized here.
- All classrooms are built with state of art infrastructure, well equipped with audio, video aids for imparting quality teaching. Fully ventilated and property natural lighting.

STUDENTS PARTICIPATION IN COLLEGE ACTIVITIES

1. The organization of activities depend upon the climate generated through teacher pupil interaction. A receptive atmosphere is likely to up hold learning situations.
2. The college begins with morning assembly prayer, through for the day and National Anthem. Each house will be on duty for a weekend is responsible for making all the arrangements.

HOSTEL

The residence life is provided to the students which contribute to him/her personal and social growth and stands them in meaningful life. The Institute has a Hostel with all necessary facilities for the limited seats only. Allotment of accommodation will be made on first come first serve bases. Hostel has its own mess run by contractor and as well as co-operative mess run by the students. All hostel affairs are managed by the committee including the Principal' Warden and Student's representative.

HOSTEL RULES:

1. All the rights of the admission to the college hostel are reserved with the Head of the institution, which are exercised on the recommendation of the Managing
2. Admission will open to the hostel in the beginning of the session. Hostel will formally close on the day of last regular examination. Each boarder will have to vacate the hostel within 72 hours after the regular examination is over
3. Every resident shall be responsible for the safety of the furniture give to him/her Damage to hostel Property is a serious offence; any boarder found guilty of damaging hostel property will be liable to for disciplinary action as per hostel rules.
4. Gambling, use of intoxicants, smoking, keeping Arms in hostel premises is strictly prohibited residents found guilty in such laps will be liable to a fine of Rs. 200/- and / or expulsion from the hostel. Warden is authorized to inspect the rooms at any time.
5. Before leaving the hostel all dues/charges of the hostel must be cleared and personally handover the charge of room and property to the Hostel Assistant Warden/Warden.
6. Once the allotment of the rooms by the warden residents are not permitted to shift the room allotted without the permission of the warden.
7. Not permitted to move to other room for sleeping without the permission of the warden.
8. Not permitted to keep emersion rods and room heaters in their room. Defaulter will be imposed a fine of Rs. 500/- and the objects will be confiscated.

For Female Residents:

9. Resident will have to apply for leave on a written Performa from the hostel warden will in advance. When they leave the hostel to go out urgently/on weekdays and they will sign the register available with the hostel Assistant Warden/Warden. They will report to the warden when return back to the hostel and mark the presence along with name of report in register.
10. All resident will report for the routine roll call daily at 7.45 PM. Any resident absenting her self without the prior permission of the warden will be fined Rs/- 50 per day and disciplinary action will be taken against the defaulters.

NOTE:

- ◆ Defiance of the hostel rules or misbehavior will render a resident student liable to disciplinary action or even expulsion from the hostel.
- ◆ The warden/college authorities will not be responsible for any loss of any valuables, jewellery or cash residents.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The resident students will be allowed an outing on Sunday & Holidays after the proper permission from the warden. A record will be kept of those who go out without permission and those who come back to the hostel later than the permitted time, serious action will be taken in case of recurring default.
2. Students going out to the local guardians will be issued a "Pass". This will be returned to the warden on their return, duly signed by the local guardian by tallying with the specimen signatures given in the hostel admission form. Admission forms for hostel must have the signature of the local guardians.
3. The visit to local guardian shall be restricted to those whose names appear in the list of local guardian furnished at the time of admission.
4. No day scholar or guest will be allowed to stay in hostel without prior permission of the principal.
5. After vacation or holidays the resident student must reach the hostel on the given date. In case of unavoidable circumstances, the parents should write directly to the Warden/Principal intimating the date of their ward's arrival.
6. Loud talking in the hostel is not allowed and complete silence should be observe.
7. Hostlers should not visit the hostel during college hours.

NOTE:

- ◆ Parents are requested to disclose the chronic illness of their wards at the time of admission, so that necessary precautions could be taken as and when required.

WHEREAS, In terms of Section 14/15 (3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Vaidh Shankar Lal memorial College of Education, Village & Post - Chandi, Tehsil-Kasauli, District- Solan, Himachal Pradesh- 173206 had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting B.Ed. Course of One Year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students on 20.03.2006

AND WHEREAS, As per the decision taken by the NRC in its 106th meeting, the recognition was granted to the above institution by NRC for B.Ed. for 100 seats from the academic session 2006-2007 in its vide order no. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/HP-179/5051 dated 23.08.2006.

AND WHEREAS, The matter was placed in its 143rd meeting held from 27th to 29th June, 2009 and NRC decided to conduct the inspection under section 17. Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution on 31.07.2009.

AND WHEREAS, The inspection of the institution u/s 17 was conducted on 12.08.2009. The VTR was considered by the NRC in its 161st meeting held from 26th to 29th May, 2010 and NRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institute on 15.07.2010 on certain grounds.

AND WHEREAS, The reply submitted by the institution in response to the points of Show Cause Notice was considered by the NRC in its 163rd meeting held from 29th to 31st July, 2010 and NRC decided to withdraw the recognition of E.T.T., B.Ed. and M.Ed. programs from 2010-11 academic session. Accordingly withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 02.09.2011 on the following grounds:

- Except Computers, the deficiencies communicated through letter number NRC/NCTE/HP-203/161th meeting/2010/25670 dated 16 July, 2010 still exist.
- Except Computers, the deficiencies communicated through letter number NRC/NCTE/HP-179/161th meeting/2010/25670 dated 16 July, 2010 still exist.
- Except Computer, the deficiencies communicated through letter number NRC/NCTE/HP-199/161th meeting/2010/25670 dated 16 July, 2010 still exist.

AND WHEREAS, The council vide order dated 27.09.2010 accepted the appeal and reversed the NRC's order dated 02.09.2010 with direction to the NRC to restore recognition of the institution for B.Ed. and ETT course only. But the recognition for M.Ed. programme stands withdrawn.


AND WHEREAS, The above said institution preferred an appeal dated 20.08.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the

aforesaid order. The matter was considered by NRC in its 193rd meeting held on 08th to 10th February, 2012. The original file of the Institution and Visiting Team Report along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time has been carefully considered by NRC.

The Committee discussed and considered the case in detail and following observations have been made:-

- The recognition of the institution be restored and order be issued.

NOW THEREFORE, the above recognition of **Vaidh Shankar Lal Memorial College of Education, Village & Post- Chandi, Tehsil-Kasauli, District- Solan, Himachal Pradesh-173206** for the **B.Ed. Course** is restored.

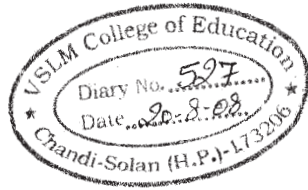

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution **Vaidh Shankar Lal Memorial College of Education, Village & Post – Chandi, Tehsil – Kasauli, Dist. – Solan, Himachal Pradesh - 173206** was recognized by NRC vide its Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/HP-179/5051 dated 23.08.2006 for B.Ed. course for 100 seats.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution **Vaidh Shankar Lal Memorial College of Education, Village & Post – Chandi, Tehsil – Kasauli, Dist. – Solan, Himachal Pradesh - 173206** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed. which require additional facilities.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely.

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The application-Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these condition by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Northern Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.


